6	<b>Lead Screening in Children</b>	Members two (2) years of age who had one (1) or more capillary or venous lead blood tests for lead poisoning in 2024 by their 2nd birthday.	<b>CPT:</b> 83655 <b>Or LOINC:</b> Codes submitted by lab
7	<b>Members with at Least one (1) PCP Visit within the Measurement Year</b>	Members who had at least one (1) PCP visit in 2024 for members assigned to the PCP group.	<b>CPT:</b> 99201-99499, if covered Medi-Cal code Visit must be in an outpatient setting – e.g., Office POS 11, FQHC POS 50. Visit must be with a provider that is contracted as a PCP or mid-level.
